2016 Domaine Carneros Ultra Brut

– This minimally-sweetened sparkler from California's Domaine Carneros has a mere 0.5 grams of sugar/liter in it, making it one of the driest sparkling wines you're likely to encounter anywhere. Big green apple melds beautifully with touches of almond paste, and the finish is all acidity. \$46 -CN



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
