CALIFORNIA

The Golden State has long been the undisputed leader when it comes to the production of bubbly in the United States. A number of the estates on this list trace their origins back to Europe, having been founded by some of the great sparkling wine houses of France and Spain. But no matter their roots, California sparklers have a distinctive style all their own, balancing richness and vibrancy while delivering streams of expressive fruit flavors. Chalk it up to the unique terroirs of Carneros and Russian River Valley, among other key regions, and to the ripeness of the Chardonnay and Pinot Noir that generally make up the blends—and then enjoy the bounty.
