### RITUAL

#### 2015 VERAMONTE "RITUAL" SAUVIGNON BLANC

*Casablanca Valley, Chile*

Light greenish gold in color, this wine smells of honey and lime juice. In the mouth, lime juice and green apple flavors have started to take on a patina with very interesting results. Hints of butterscotch and honey are woven through the greener flavors. Nice acidity. 14% alcohol. Proof, perhaps, that you don't have to drink your screwcapped Sauvignon Blanc immediately.

**Score: around 8.5. Cost: \$20.**
