Take a trip through Prosecco Road, which sits between the towns of Conegliano and Valdobbiadene.



The region, which is home to Prosecco and has been labeled a UNESCO World Heritage site, takes travelers on a journey to a handful of remote villages and towns in the hilly countryside.
