Officially known as Conegliano Valdobbiadene Prosecco Superiore DOCG, is a region located in the Veneto region of Northern Italy. Prosecco DOCG is the area between Conegliano and Valdobbiadene between Venice and the Dolomites. With 15 communes, the terroir is what makes Prosecco DOCG significantly superior in quality and style. The wines are of the highest quality



and in August of 2009, it was awarded the DOCG appellation designation, placing it amongst Italy's greatest wines. The region is also on its way to becoming a UNESCO world heritage site.
