Vineyard Sources: 22% from Stokes Vineyard in San Joaquin, 21% Scheid Vineyard in Monterey County, 14% from Live Oak & Windy Hills Vineyards in Paso Robles, 13% Kick on Vineyard in Santa Maria Valley, 12% from French Camp in Paso Robles, 3% Simpson Vineyard in Fresno County and 15% from Vineyards in Santa Barbara County.
