Glen Ellen, CA – Sullivan Birney Winery & Vineyards celebrates this 4th of July holiday with a tasting of its award winning REDS (Pinot Noirs), WHITES (Chardonnays) and will offer a free BLUES compilation CD to the first 50 visitors to their tasting room on Sunday, July 4th. Blues music will provide a backdrop for visitors to the tasting room located in bucolic “downtown” Glen Ellen (at the corner of Arnold Drive and Warm Springs Road). The tasting room combines a mix of shabby chic, fine wines and historic exhibits about 19th century Glen Ellen as well as two literary local denizens, MFK Fisher and Jack London.

Established in 1998 by Rick Sullivan and Jonelle Birney Sullivan, Sullivan Birney has vineyards in both the Sonoma Mountain and Sonoma Coast appellations where the talented consulting winemaker, Rolando Herrera, makes both Chardonnay and Pinot Noir wines. Recent awards from the Los Angeles County Fair, the San Francisco Chronicle Wine Competition and the Orange County Wine Society (4 star gold medal and “Best of Show” for the 2002 Sonoma Mountain Chardonnay) have quickly established a buzz about this new winery.
