



'Rosé All Day'

Humphry Slocombe has released Rosé All Day sorbet, lightly infused with Domaine Carneros Brut Rosé.



Finally, just in time for National Rosé Day on June 12, San Francisco's inventive, small-batch ice cream makers Humphry Slocombe has, once again, partnered with Domaine Carneros, to create a "Rosé All Day" sorbet that is lightly infused with Domaine Carneros Brut Rosé. "Pink bubbles make everything better," said Jake Godby, Humphry Slocombe's co-founder, and chef. Domaine Carneros's CEO Remi Cohen predicted their Rosé fans "will love this surprising interpretation."

It was necessary, of course, to sample the sorbet before writing about it. It is delicious, or, as Godby called it, "summer in a glass." The sorbet is available at Humphry Slocombe's Mission District and other locations by the scoop (\$4.95) or pint (\$9.99) and via Gold Belly in a four-pack for \$79 including tax and shipping. Rosé All Day will stay on the menu until June 27 unless it sells out. In this case, you can just open a bottle of the Domaine Carneros Brut Rosé, summer in a bottle.
