PRIMUS

2014 Primus "The Blend" Red Blend, Colchagua Valley, Chile

Dark garnet in the glass, this wine smells of tapenade, cherries, and a touch of herbs. In the mouth, cherry and black cherry flavors mix with spiced molasses and hints of green herbs. Sandpapery tannins linger in the finish along with hints of chopped herbs. Good acidity and length. 14% alcohol.

Score: around 8.5. Cost: \$18.
