Napa Valley Blueline Vineyard 2010 | \$125 Offers a floral aroma, with blueberry and blackberry fruit folded in, showing hints of crushed rock and graphite. Eases up a bit on the finish, revealing chewy tannins. Drink now through 2024. 1,200 cases made. —J.L.

well. The 2010 (\$68) is more generous than the 2009, presenting plenty backbone and tannins. Cellani (\$80) steps closer to the \$100 mark, as doe the \$90 Adler Deutsch. Both are graceful and easy to drink.
