## Tim Fish's Recommended California Merlots

**HOURGLASS** Merlot Napa Valley Blueline Vineyard 2008

A sleek and plush Merlot, yet layered with delicate complexity.

Since my last report on the variety ("Merlot's Perfect Timing," Nov. 30, 2010), I have blind-tasted more than 120 new releases from multiple vintages in our Napa office, with 26 wines rating an outstanding 90 points or higher on the Wine Spectator 100-point scale. (A free alphabetical list of scores and prices for all wines tasted is available at www.winespectator.com/113011.)

Two wines topped the list with 94 points, and both are Merlotdominant blends. Pride's Claret Reserve Sonoma-Napa Counties 2007 (\$125) is lush and complex, with red currant and toasty, bitter mocha aromas that lead to layered flavors of black raspberry, creamy; the sleek Hourglass Napa Valley Blueline Vineyard 2008 (\$75) shows delicate complexity; the Paloma Spring Mountain District 2008 (\$54) is supple and plush; and the Moone-Tsai Howell Mountain 2008 (\$65) offers depth and focus. The latter wine, crafted by Philippe Melka, hails from a new partnership between MaryAnn and Larry Tsai and California wine veteran Mike Moone.

"Tannin management was really important in 2008," says Melka, who was also responsible for the Melka Métisse La Mekerra Vineyard Knights Valley 2007 (92 points, \$125) and Seavey Merlot Napa Valley 2008 (90, \$45). "Because the berries were very small,
