Veramonte has been controlled by the Gonzalez Byass winery, from Spain, since 2016. One of the leading wineries in Casablanca, the company only uses organic estate-owned grapes from there and Colchagua; Marchigue and Apalta. Focused on quality terroir driven wines, Primus 2016 and Neyen 2015 are Bordeaux Style reds while Ritual is a Burgundy style Pinot Noir from a warm year.

Red wine from Chile | Drinking window: 2020 - 2028

55% Cabernet Sauvignon and 45% Carménère from Apalta, Neyen 2015 is dark in color with a brick-dust meniscus. It presents a moderate nose of cassis, mint and blackberry given oxidative character by the aging process (four years in barrels and casks), along with a terse texture and a classically expressive finish.
