It's green. Officials at the industry-backed Wine Institute announced a program Wednesday that outlines steps growers and winemakers must take to call themselves "sustainable." The regulations cover everything from energy and water consumption to health care for workers and relationships with neighbors. Independent auditors will enforce compliance.
